LINDA MARTINELLO: TIME AND TERRAIN

Time and Terrain: Along the Côte d'Azur features paintings and studies conceptualised during Linda

Martinello's 2022 residency with La Napoule Art Foundation. Martinello worked in a studio situated

within the Château de La Napoule, nestled along the Mediterranean coast in the South of France. The

studio opened directly onto the castle's courtyard, providing Martinello unhindered views of the

mountains and the Bay of Cannes.

Martinello views her time in the South of France as a transformative experience. She reflects, "my

encounters with nature, ranging from the rhythmic waves against cliffside to the dappled sunlight in

hillside forests, served as continual inspiration for my site documentation and research." Martinello

went for daily morning hikes along the coastline and into hillside trails. This was the time of day when

the natural colours of the landscape were most intense. The changing light and delicate balance between

the rocks, sun and sea, layered the landscape with optical movement and patterns. She was especially

captivated by the juxtaposition between the red rocky Alpes-Maritimes mountains and the azure and

turquoise water, where rock and sea reinforce visually the geographical duality of the region.

Martinello describes the process of bringing these sensory experiences into the studio as a ritual of

translation, through which the play of light, the vibrant colours, and the textural nuances observed

during her walks found expression in the paintings.

"Each brushstroke became a deliberate attempt to capture the essence of those moments, creating a
